

Safe Routes to School

I would like to thank Kanab City, UDOT and the Health Department for their combined efforts in installing the new sidewalks to our schools. According to Kanab City Manager, Joe Decker, the expense of the project was approximately \$591,000, which was funded with \$35,000 from the Health Department, a Safe Route to School grant from UDOT for \$260,000 with the remaining \$296,000 provided by Kanab City. We appreciate Kanab City improving the safety of our students with the installation of the new sidewalks. In conjunction with the Safe Routes to School and Utah code [53A-3-402 \(17\)](#), the Kane County School Board will be establishing a district traffic safety committee to receive suggestions from the community on recommendations to improve school traffic safety. The district traffic safety committee will review the safe routes to school and make suggestions to enhance student safety. Additionally, the committee will provide training to all district students in grades K-6 on school crossing safety and safe routes to school.
