Student Enrollment 2018

The Utah State Board of Education recently reviewed the student enrollment numbers for the state, which show there are an estimated 660,000 students attending public school. The state saw an increase of 7,561 new students over the previous year. Compared to other states, Utah is unique with 1 in 5 people attending a public school. In 2017 the population of Kane County was estimated at 7,567 people, with a student enrollment of 1,355, which shows that we are paralleling the state ratios with approximately 1 in 5 people in the county enrolled in school. At this same time last year, the Kane School District had a student population of 1328, showing an increase of 27 new students over the prior year. In our schools we have four grades with over 80 students, those include KES 4th, KMS 7th and 8th, and KHS 10th grade. We are very fortunate as a rural district to continue to see increasing student enrollments, which are tied directly to the employment opportunities in our area.
