UHSAA Alignment 2019-2021

Every two years the Utah High School Activity Association (UHSAA) completes realignment for all extracurricular activities in the state, which includes region and classifications for all participating schools. In December of 2018 the UHSAA Board of Trustees approved the new region and classifications for the upcoming fall 2019 and can be found at <u>https://www.uhsaa.org/realignment/2019-21Regions.pdf</u> The new realignments will remain in place until 2021. One of the biggest changes in the new UHSAA realignment is the elimination of the 1A football classification. Kanab High School football will be in a 2A South Region with Beaver, Enterprise, Milford, Millard, North Sevier and Parowan. The North Region will consist of Altamont, Duchesne, Gunnison, Layton Christian, Monticello, North Summit and Rich. For all other extra-curricular activities, Kanab will be in a 2A classification in Region 18 with Enterprise, Beaver, Millard, and Parowan. Valley High School will be in a 1A Region 20 classification with Bryce Valley, Diamond Ranch, Escalante, Panguitch, Piute, Water Canyon, Wayne and Lava Heights.
