

## **Fiscal Year 2019 Budget**

During the June Kane County School Board meeting, the board will be considering amendments to the 2018 fiscal year budget, and the proposed 2019 fiscal year budget for the upcoming school year. The budget hearing will be held at the school district office on June 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. We would encourage you to attend. The Kane District 2018 budget does **not** include a tax increase for the upcoming school year. According to the 2017 tax rates, Kane School District has the fifth lowest tax rate in the state and spends approximately \$12,656 per student, which is the third highest student expenditure in the state. Essentially, the school district collects one of the lowest local tax rates and spends substantially more per student when compared to other districts.
