FERPA Consent to Release Student Information

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. In accordance with FERPA, it is Kane School District's policy to withhold certain educational records unless the student's parent or an adult student provides consent to disclose the information. The purpose of this form is to provide the consent to Kane School District required by FERPA.
