Emergency Parent Notifications

In light of recent events, I would like to discuss a few of our district emergency procedures and protocol as it relates to parent notification. In the event of a school emergency, parents will receive a phone call through the parent link system, which is the same system used to notify parents of student absences and to receive messages from the school principals. It is very important for parents to check their contact numbers listed in the Student Information System (SIS/ASPIRE) as they are used to make the phone calls in an emergency situation. Parents can log into the SIS system to change or check your contact numbers that are currently stored in the system. Also, you are welcome to contact the school secretaries to make any needed changes in the SIS system. It would be beneficial if parents will also check to make sure the schools have a current email contact in the SIS system to receive attachments and documents. When parents receive Parent Link notifications, please listen to the message and try to avoid calling the schools as this ties up our phone systems and personnel. Please know that we are actively working to improve our school security and work closely with our local law enforcement agencies in procedures and practices. Student safety is always our top priory. I would like to thank our local and County law enforcement agencies for their diligent efforts in improving our school safety.
