
ACT Index

On October 27, 2018, many of our students will be taking the ACT, which is a nationally normed college readiness assessment. The ACT has established the minimum benchmark scores for college readiness in English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. The benchmarks are as follows: English composition: 18, College Algebra: 22, Social Science: 22, and Biology: 23. Students have many resources to help them prepare for the ACT, which include practice test, online resources such as (SCHMOOP) http://www.shmoop.com/act/test-prep.html and BYU Independent Study ACT prep courses. The district has also purchased ACT study guide books for all of the students who are enrolled in ACT prep class. All students have the option to enroll in an ACT prep courses in the Kane District to help them improve their scores and become eligible for college scholarships. Universities use the student's ACT and GPA score to grant scholarships based on an admission index. Each university creates their own ACT and GPA index. Simply put, a higher ACT score equates to higher scholarship for students.
