

Essential Take-Aways:

1. You can give yourself a valuable scholarship while still in high school if you are willing to put in a little extra effort.

Would you rather pay \$15 per 3 credit class (\$5 per credit) for concurrent enrollment (with the added bonus of receiving high school credit as well as college credit) – basically killing two birds with one stone – while living at home with free food, housing, and transportation?

OR

Pay \$644 for the **same** 3 credit class on-campus, plus the added costs of food, housing and transportation?

2. Students considering Concurrent Enrollment classes are encouraged to register for those they want and THEN work high school classes around the EdNet schedule rather than waiting to get their high school schedule first. Please see the class credit conversion chart.

Preferential Registration for FALL classes opens March 1st each year.

Preferential Registration for SPRING classes opens November 1st each year.

Admission to a college and Registration for classes are TWO separate activities. Admission is a one-time event. Registration is done for each class you want to take each semester.
