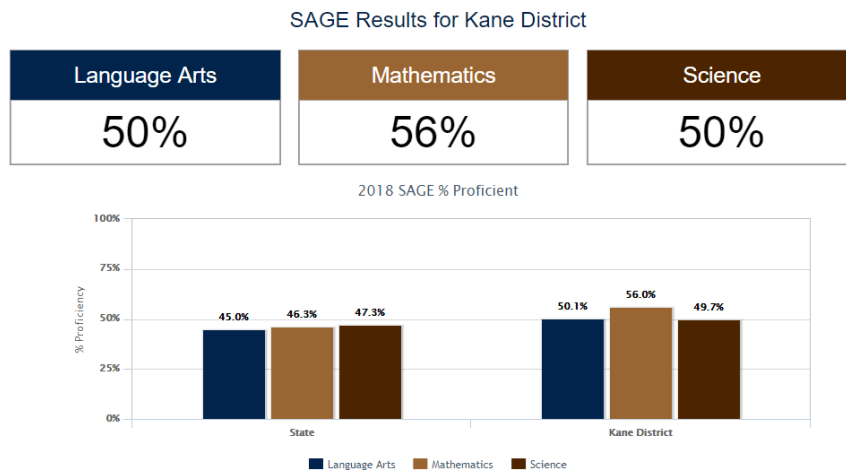


SAGE Summary 2018

The Utah State Board of Education (USBE) recently released the results of the 2017-2018 end-of-level SAGE proficiency scores. I'm pleased to report to the public that Kane School District exceeded the Utah State averages in all three categories (Language Arts, Math and Science). I would like to extend a special thanks to our faculty and staff, and to the parents who help ensure our students' academic success. The 6-8th grade science proficiency levels are not available in the report due to new state standards, but should be available in December 2018. As a reminder, the USBE has placed the SAGE test with the new testing platform titled RISE, for grades 3-8, while students in grades 9 and 10 will take the Utah ACT Aspire Plus exams in the 2018-2019 school year. The Utah ACT Aspire Plus exam will be a hybrid between the traditional SAGE and the ACT Aspire in the 2018-2019 school year. High school juniors will continue to take the ACT exam.
