

SafeUT

Kane County School District has partnered with Utah State Board of Education, and the Utah Legislature to allow our students access to the SafeUT Crisis and Safety Tip Line. Students throughout our district can now access counselors 24-hours a day by using the SafeUT mobile app or by calling 1-800-272-8255 to talk about anything the student may be struggling with. The designated provider is the University of Utah's Neuropsychiatric Institute (UNI) where all interactions are handled by licensed clinicians as part of their comprehensive crisis response services. Students who call or start a crisis chat or text through the mobile app or web will connect directly to a UNI crisis counselor. In addition to the 24-hour counseling resource, students can anonymously submit a text through the SafeUT app that allows students to report tips on bullying, cyberbullying, drug and alcohol activity, and more. When a tip is submitted, an anonymous four-digit number is provided from the University of Utah that allows for building administrators to respond to the individuals for additional information. SafeUT app helps to provide students with a safe and secure school environment and it provides our school administration with the communication and management tools needed to help manage our campus situations. Students will receive training on how to use the SafeUT mobile by their school administrator. The SafeUT app can be downloaded through the Apple and Google app stores.
