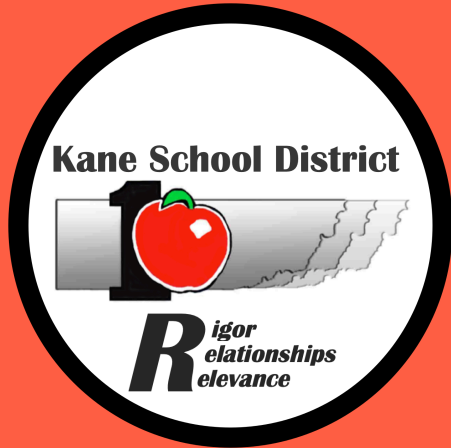

## **What's wrong with the existing school?**

### **Student Safety**

- Built in 1953, it is not up to seismic, fire and accessibility codes. Would cost \$13.8 million to remodel.
- Drop-off and Pick-up areas are not adequate for student population and present safety hazards for students.
- Modular units are disconnected from main school, which is a safety concern.

### **Overcrowding: Lack of Instructional Space**

- A new building would be a 70,000+ square foot facility with an estimated life of 50 to 60 years and can accommodate up to 700 students. The current Kanab Elementary School building is 40,805 square feet, which is only accommodating current student count of just under 500 by using several modular classroom units.
- No room for all students to meet for assemblies, not enough seating for parents to come for programs.
- Lunch room too small for all kids to eat lunch, some eat outside.
- Closets are used for student Intervention space, which is a fire hazard.

### **Maintenance Issues**

- Coal boiler is out of date, difficult and costly to keep running and lacks proper ventilation.
- The current roof needs to be replaced. The cost would be \$250,000 for one section.
- Rather than try to keep up with the cost of maintaining an outdated building, let's put that money toward a new school!

## **What problems will a new school solve?**

- Provide sufficient instructional space.
- Provide additional space for student intervention.
- Provide a public school building that is constructed to current seismic, fire and accessibility codes.
- Provide adequate space to accommodate increases in student enrollment.
- Provide adequate heating and cooling with proper ventilation for student and employee health.
- Provide a multipurpose (gymnasium) area where students can eat lunch and provide seating for parents and students for school sponsored activities.
- Provide adequate pick up and drop off locations to improve student safety.

## **Why the GO Bond is the best choice?**

- Provide our community with a new, very needed school!
- Allow the District to borrow at the lowest interest rate – saving taxpayers approx. \$2,000,000 over the course of the bond.
