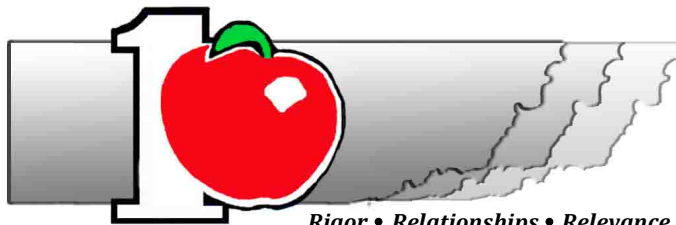

To Whom It May Concern:

Kane County School District announces a soft closure of schools for a minimum of two weeks or until further notice beginning March 16, 2020. The school closure is a result of the recommendations from the Southwest Health Department, Utah Health Department, Utah State Board of Education, as well as our own staff, relating to possible Coronavirus exposure. In an effort to be proactive, the district will close all seven schools for at least two weeks or until further notice. The school closures include the postponement of all student travel including extra-curricular activities.

Teachers will provide digital education to the students through their Chromebooks and online curriculum programs. We are confident in KSD teachers' ability to provide instruction in a digital setting. If you have questions for teachers, please contact them through their emails, which can be found on the individual school webpages. Student online instruction will begin on Tuesday, March 17.
