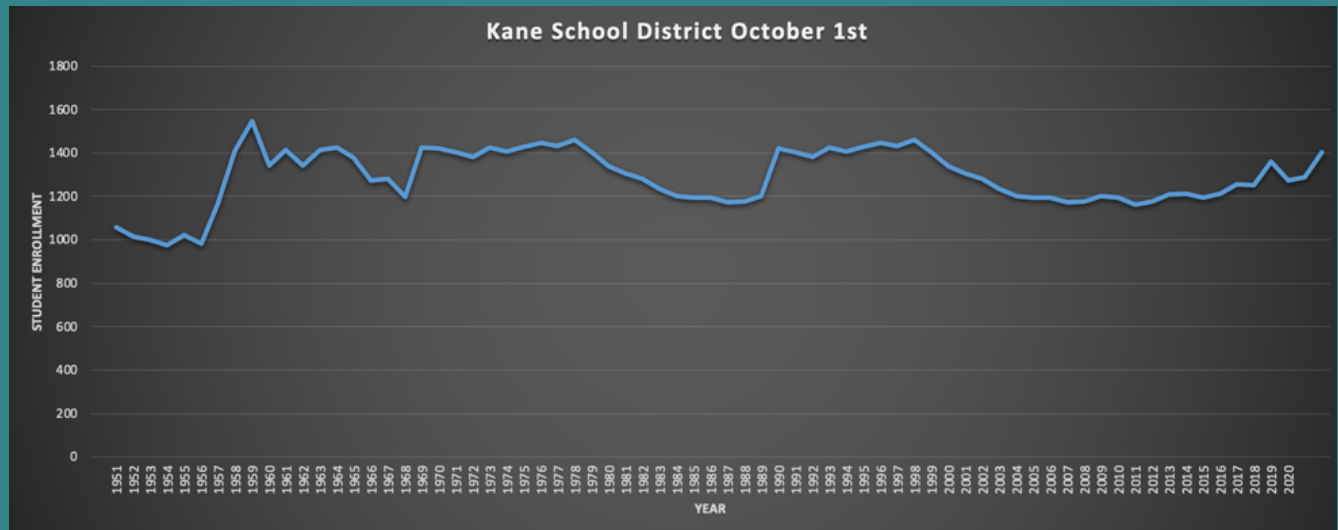


Kane School District 5-year Snapshot
