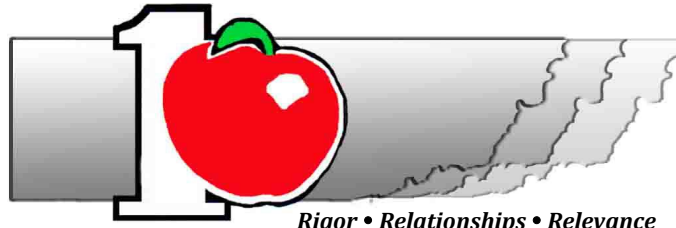


# Kane School District

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## Request for Proposal (RFP) for Kane County School: Elementary Math Curriculum Adoption

- 1. Introduction:** Kane County School District invites proposals from qualified vendors to provide an elementary math curriculum for grades K-6. The selected curriculum will be implemented district-wide and must meet the standards set forth by the Utah State Board of Education (USBE). The primary objective of this RFP is to identify a comprehensive math curriculum that aligns with USBE standards, offers online access, digital text, professional development training, and demonstrates acceptance to the Utah State Board of Education Recommended Instructional Materials (RIMS). The implementation will be for the 2025-26 school year.
- 2. Scope of Work:** The selected vendor will provide a comprehensive elementary math curriculum for grades K-6, including but not limited to textbooks, digital resources, online access, and professional development training for teachers. The curriculum should cover all essential math concepts outlined by the Utah State Board of Education for each grade level.
- 3. Requirements:**
  - a. Alignment with Utah State Board of Education Standards:** The proposed curriculum must demonstrate alignment with the Utah State Board of Education standards for elementary math education.
  - b. Price:** Vendors must provide transparent pricing for their curriculum, including any additional costs for online access, professional development training, or supplementary materials.
  - c. Online Access:** The curriculum should offer online access for both teachers and students, including interactive resources and assessments.
  - d. Digital Text:** Vendors must provide digital versions of textbooks and supplementary materials compatible with standard digital platforms.
  - e. Professional Development Training:** The selected vendor will be responsible for providing comprehensive professional development training for teachers to effectively implement the curriculum.
  - f. Acceptance to Utah State Board of Education RIMS:** Vendors must demonstrate acceptance to the Utah State Board of Education Recommended Instructional Materials (RIMS) program.
  - g. Material Review Samples:** Vendors must provide samples of their curriculum materials for review by the evaluation committee.

4. **Proposal Submission:** Interested vendors should submit their proposals electronically to woodj@kane.k12.ut.us no later than June 14, 2024. Proposals should include the following:
  - a. Company profile, including experience in providing elementary math curriculum.
  - b. Detailed description of the proposed curriculum, including alignment with USBE standards.
  - c. Pricing structure, including any additional costs for online access, professional development, and supplementary materials.
  - d. Sample materials for review.
  - e. Evidence of acceptance to the Utah State Board of Education RIMS program.
  - f. Proposed timeline for curriculum implementation and professional development training.
5. **Evaluation Criteria:**

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

  - a. Alignment with USBE standards (30%)
  - b. Price competitiveness (20%)
  - c. Quality of online access and digital resources (15%)
  - d. Professional development training plan (15%)
  - e. Acceptance to USBE RIMS program (10%)
  - f. Sample material review (10%)
6. **Selection Process:** The evaluation committee will review all proposals based on the evaluation criteria outlined above. Shortlisted vendors may be invited for presentations or interviews. The final selection will be based on the best overall value and fit for Kane County School District.
7. **Terms and Conditions:** Kane County School District reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive any informality or irregularity in the proposals received, and to accept or reject any items of the proposal in part or in whole. The selected vendor will be required to enter into a contract with Kane County School District outlining the terms and conditions of the agreement.
