

Kane County School District Announces Lark Reynolds as the new Business Administrator



Lark Reynolds grew up in Panguitch, Utah, before attending Southern Utah University, where he earned his bachelor's degree in accounting in 2005 and met his wife, Mitzi. He later moved to Salt Lake City to pursue his Master of Accounting at the University of Utah, graduating in 2007. After completing his education, Lark began his career in public accounting as a tax preparer for a Salt Lake City CPA firm and became a licensed CPA in 2009.

Shortly thereafter, he transitioned into school finance when he was appointed Business Administrator for Garfield County School District. During his three years there, he had the unique experience of working with four different superintendents —the last being Ben Dalton.

Lark later moved with his young family to Tooele, where he accepted the role of Business Administrator for Tooele County School District. In Tooele, he oversaw a budget exceeding \$300 million and signed the issuance of more than \$300 million in bonds, enabling the construction of five new elementary schools, one junior high, and one high school across the county.
